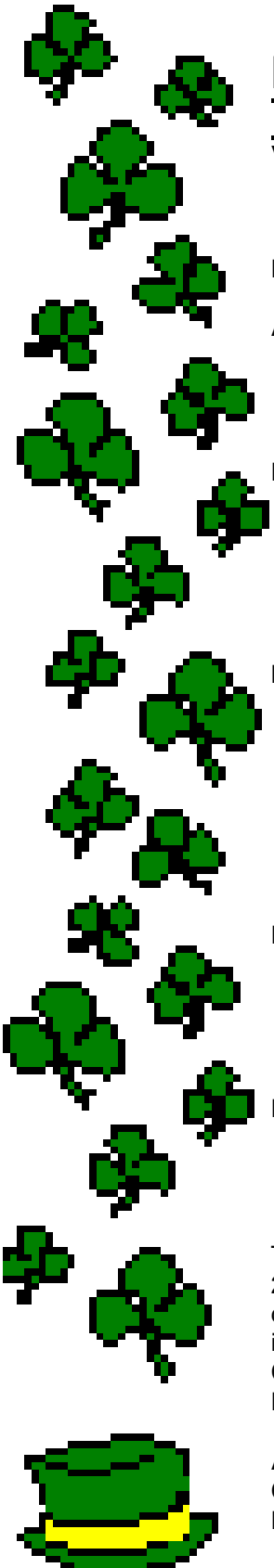
### Monitoring & Intrusion Detection
