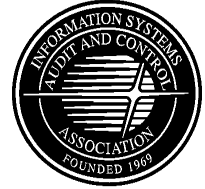



Collection of Volatile Evidence From Computer Crime Scenes

Volatile evidence is electronic evidence that will disappear once a computer is powered off. This would include the contents of memory, the status of network interfaces, information about the currently running processes, currently active network connections and mounted network file systems. Unfortunately, collecting this volatile evidence can leave footprints on other less volatile evidence, such as free space on the local disk drives, or the contents of the swap space. Consequently, there's a tension between the need to collect volatile evidence and the need to preserve more traditional, non-volatile evidence.

This month's speaker is Mr. Steve Romig, Manager of Campus Network Security at The Ohio State University. Steve is in charge of the University's Incident Response Team, which provides computer security, incident response assistance, training, consulting, and security auditing service for the university community. In addition, he works closely with central Ohio businesses to improve Internet security response and practices, as well as with local, state, and federal law enforcement to detect and deter computer crime.

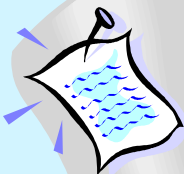

K-NET Services

K-NET, a global knowledge network for IT governance, control and assurance, has recently added a feature to allow searching of its knowledge database. With 12 subject areas, more than 90 topic areas and more than 1,400 references, this feature provides quick results when searching by words or phrases throughout the database.

This Internet-based compendium of knowledge is updated weekly to include articles, books and web sites that have been peer-reviewed by members of the association. References are expected to more than double over the next twelve months. As the number of references increases, the search engine will become even more valuable.
