**Meeting Topic:** Collaborative for Enterprise Transformation and Innovation (CETI) at The Ohio State University  
**Speaker:** Dr. Jay Ramanathan, Ph.D.

#### Synopsis:

CETI provides an infrastructure for the creation and dissemination of knowledge to achieve broader impact in several program areas. The areas are 1) ACE architecture knowledge, 2) Innovation frameworks, and 3) Enterprise Knowledge Infrastructure and next-generation portals. The broader impact includes a workforce with skills to exploit the knowledge and create new opportunities, validation of knowledge through practice, collaboration with regional and national bodies for dissemination and standards influence.
